The National Science Foundation hereby awards a grant of \$890,168 to Fort Worth Museum of Science and History for support of the project described in the proposal referenced above as modified by revised budget dated July 6, 2004.

This project, entitled "TexNET: Texas Network for Exhibit-based Learning and Teaching," is under the direction of Charlie Walter, Joe Hastings, Robert L. Lindsey.

This award is effective August 15, 2004 and expires July 31, 2006.
